ORDER

This matter having come before the Court on the Chapter 7 Trustee’s Motion For Authority To Sell Certain Assets By Way Of On-Line Auction, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that said motion is granted and that the Trustee is authorized to sell the 1969 Plymouth GTX motor vehicle bearing VIN # RS23L9A131925 and a 1970 Dodge Coronet motor vehicle bearing VIN # WH23G0A157323 as follows:

- By way of on-line auction to be conducted by St. Jean Auctioneers during the sixteen (16) day period of November 14, 2017 – November 30, 2017. St. Jean shall set a reserve for the 1969 Plymouth GTX of \$7,500.00 and the 1970 Dodge Coronet of \$5,000.00. For the commission of St. Jean Auctioneers in addition to the purchase price, the successful bidder for each motor vehicle shall be charged and be responsible to pay a buyers premium of seventeen percent (17%) of the purchase price, subject to the Trustee’s right to amend or alter the terms of said on-line auction.
- THE SALE OF EACH MOTOR VEHICLE IS TO BE “AS IS” AND “WHERE IS” WITHOUT ANY REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND. AND EXPRESSLY EXCLUDES ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

IT IS ALSO FURTHER ORDERED that the Trustee’s Notice Of Intended Sale (Doc. 115) is approved; the fourteen (14) day stay imposed by Bankruptcy Rule 6004(h) is hereby waived; and that the Trustee shall file a report of sale within 14 days of the closing on each sale. SO ORDERED.
