TERMS OF SALE: A deposit of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars in the form of cash, a certified check, bank treasurer's check or funds satisfactory to Mortgagee will be required to be delivered at or before the time a bid is offered. The successful bidder will be required to execute a Purchase and Sale Agreement immediately after the close of the bidding. The balance of the purchase price shall be paid on or before thirty (30) days from date of sale. If the successful bidder fails to complete the purchase of the Mortgaged Premises in accordance with the preceding sentence, then the Mortgagee may retain the deposit in full as liquidated damages resulting from the successful bidder's failure to perform. 
