**CHAPTER 7 TRUSTEE'S NOTICE OF INTENDED
SALE OF CERTAIN ASSET BY PUBLIC AUCTION FREE AND CLEAR OF
ALL LIENS, CLAIMS AND ENCUMBRANCES**

1. Notice is hereby given, pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §363, Fed. R. Bankr. P. 2002(a)(2) and 6004 and LBR 2002-1 and 6004-1(b), that Olga L. Gordon, the Chapter 7 Trustee (the "Trustee") of the estate of Parrillo Designs, LLC dba Derailed Boutique (the "Debtor") intends to sell at public auction, free and clear of all liens, claims and encumbrances all of the Trustee's right, title and interest in the following assets: *Inventory and fixtures, more specifically -*

Loveseat, chairs & stools (the "Assets").

2. The Assets will be sold at a public auction to be held on-line to close on March 15, 2021 or at a date and time thereafter.¹

3. James R. St. Jean Auctioneers will conduct the auction for the Trustee (the “Auctioneer”). (See www.jsjauctions.com)

4. The Trustee believes that there are no secured claims against the Assets.

5. THE SALE IS “AS IS” AND “WHERE IS” WITHOUT ANY REPRESENTATIONS OR WARRANTIES OF ANY KIND, AND EXPRESSLY EXCLUDES ANY WARRANTY OF MERCHANTABILITY AND FITNESS FOR A PARTICULAR PURPOSE.

6. The Trustee reserves the right to amend or alter the terms of the Auction.

7. Unless a creditor or other party in interest files a written objection to said proposed Auction with the Court, the Auctioneer will proceed to conduct the aforesaid auction of the Assets as contemplated herein without further action of the Court.

8. Any and all objections to the Chapter 7 Trustee’s Motion for Authority to Sell Certain Assets By Way of Public Auction (the “Motion to Sell”) must be filed in writing with the Clerk of the Court, United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire, Warren B. Rudman United States Courthouse, 55 Pleasant Street, Concord, New Hampshire 03301 on or before February 27, 2021 and copies thereof delivered to the Trustee at the address listed below.

9. Any objection shall state the Debtors’ name, case number and in addition, state what, if any, interest the party filing an objection has in the case and specifically state the basis of any such objection.

¹ Interested parties should contact the Auctioneer to confirm the date and time of the Auction.

10. If no objection to the sale is timely filed, the Bankruptcy Court in its discretion may grant the Motion.

11. The Court will hold a hearing on the Motion To Sell on March 3, 2021 at **9:00 a.m.** at the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of New Hampshire, Warren B. Rudman United States Courthouse, Courtroom A, 55 Pleasant Street, Concord, New Hampshire 03301.

12. Any party filing an objection must be present at the hearing.

13. The Trustee reserves the right to reject any and all bids and to remove property from the Auction if she deems such action to be in the best interest of the bankruptcy estate.
